

Hello Trinity,

January 1<sup>st</sup> marks a New Year for us. January 1<sup>st</sup> also marks the first official day of my serving you as Interim Minister. It became evident to me right away that your greatest desire and need was to have someone care for you. Providing Pastoral Care to the congregation has always been an important focus for me. I believe it is the strength of ministry in a congregation such as Trinity Lutheran. I look forward to serving you in this kind of way. And I look forward to the care and support and love that you have already shown to me in these past few weeks.

Many of you know already that I had plans to visit my son and his family in Minnesota over Christmas. I wish I could also celebrate Christmas with you, but I will remember the congregation in prayer and trust that each of you, along with those you love, will have had a blessed holiday (since you will likely read this after it is over). I will be back with you for the last weekend of the year. Pastor Arter will continue to serve as your local interim through this time if you are in need of pastoral care.

The Church Council has asked me to work 30 hours a week instead of the normal interim which is 20 hours. I have agreed to this. But to prepare for worship and preaching, to serve well on both Saturday evening and Sunday morning, to visit people, attend meetings and church functions, that 30 hours will not go far. I also have to travel from Fombell (on the other side of Zelienople) which takes just over an hour (no matter which way I choose to come). So I must use my time well.

I have been asked if I will have regular office hours. At this point I will not. I would rather be out and about, being involved, rather than sitting and waiting in an office. So I ask this of each of you. If I can ever support you in any way, please do not hesitate to contact me. I want to know if you are in the hospital, sick, or just need to talk about a concern. I have always said to call me at any time. I am never bothered by a call in the middle of the night.

After the first of the year, I will be also looking at making contact with families. I will be available to prepare your children for baptism, first communion, confirmation. I only had one wedding in my two and a half year interim in Sewickley, but what a joy to have that opportunity just a few weeks before I ended my time with them. There new pastor started November 11<sup>th</sup>.

January 1<sup>,</sup> 2019. It is my hope that it marks the beginning of a fruitful ministry between pastor and congregation, as I help you discover and look forward to the next stage of your future. Please, let us enjoy one another as we serve the Lord.

2018 has been a difficult year for many folks. This is also true for Trinity Lutheran Church.

Last April, the Bishop contacted me about serving as your local interim pastor for what was expected to be a very brief period—one month, *give-or-take*. There was the shared expectation that a transitional interim pastor would soon be designated, who would lead you along the next steps towards new pastoral leadership.

Needless to say, things did not work out according to those plans. Over the next eight months, your weekend worship services were led by numerous different supply pastors and lay worship leaders. And just when you thought you saw the way forward, something unexpected happened. A door was closed. The pathway before you disappeared. I've personally experienced this disappointment countless times—unable to move in the direction I believed was right.

Now, more than ever, we are anxious about the future of our congregations. Longtime members pass away, while others stop coming. Younger generations keep turning away from church. Offerings shrink, and savings dwindle. Meanwhile, big churches keep getting bigger. Their praise bands and elaborate children's programs attract what few young families are interested in the church. We ask, *what are we doing wrong? Why aren't we reaching people? Are we perishing?* 

Despite all the losses and setbacks you've endured, God has been working. Your congregation council voted unanimously to enter into a contract with Rev. Bob Keplinger, a retired pastor with 35 years of experience in ordained ministry. In the short time I've known him, I have been thoroughly impressed by his expertise, his knowledge of God's Word and Lutheran Confessions, and his dedication to caring for the family of God.

And over the past eight months, it has been a joy to witness your passion and dedication to Christ's mission in the world. You are reaching out to your community. You are caring for the Trailblazers. Your children are learning about God's love in Sunday School and participating in the life of the church. And though it is impossible to know exactly where your congregation will be in ten years, Christ owns the future. God will provide everything you need to move forward into that future.

A new day has dawned at Trinity. For that, I rejoice. Thank you for the opportunities you have given me, brief and few as they have been, to journey with you in Christ, share his love, and witness his faithfulness.




