Pastor's Page



"Thy kingdom come, thy will be done...

...on earth as it is in heaven."

Easter and the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus will soon be upon us. This year I invite you to think about it in terms of the Lord's Prayer. I believe it is to give shape to how we believe and hope and live.

We tend to be fascinated with questions about immortality and about what happens when we die. But while we are asking our questions, we are surely dying. Death is more than just that moment when the body shuts down, the lungs stop taking in that life-giving air, the hearts stops pumping the blood that pulsates life. Death reigns, even within us, whenever and wherever there is resistance to God's rule.

What if the Resurrection of Jesus is God's own answer to our prayer, "thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." The Bible is the story of the resistance of humanity, and even creation itself, to the reign and will of God. The Resurrection of Jesus is God's assertion of reign over all things, even death itself. That is why the Apostle Paul refers to it in this way: "the last enemy to be destroyed is death."

Paul calls upon death in that famous chapter from 1 Corinthians (chapter 15) to assert its victory. But then he reminds death, and we along with the whole world, that the victory belongs to God. Paul goes on to tell us the mystery as to how we shall all be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye. But what if the Apostle Paul is more concerned about the present moment in which we live. We are to experience the victory of the Resurrection of Jesus, and its transforming power, for this life here and now.

So listen to what he says. If the Resurrection of Jesus is simply the figment of imagination, then we might as well just eat and drink, for tomorrow (or someday) we die. And we can forget praying the Lord's Prayer. But for Paul, the Resurrection of Jesus is God's assertion of God's reign and will here on earth (as it is already in heaven). We pray for that victory to come upon us, perhaps even is this moment, in the twinkling of an eye.

So I leave you with the words that Paul ends this chapter on the Resurrection of Jesus.

"Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord, because you know that in the Lord your labor is not in vain."


